Nursery, Preschool, & Kiddoz Coordinator (10-15 hrs)

Job Description

Think of yourself as a MINISTER to children and a HUGE servant to our Children's Ministry Volunteers. Your organization helps to equip others to serve.

The purpose of this role is to:

- Recruit train and manage nursery, preschool and Kiddoz volunteers.
- Confirm Background check on volunteers with GraceKidz Director/GraceKidz Admin.
- Provide training videos to new volunteers and GraceKidz handbooks.
- Assign workers to groups/rooms.
- Supervise and assist in all nursery and preschool rooms as needed on Sunday mornings and in the Kiddoz room on Wednesday nights.

• Teaching and demonstrating God's love to our volunteers, families, babies, and young children of Grace New Hope.

Weekly:

<u>Monday</u>: Work from home - calling visitors, following up with volunteers who were out on Sunday and going through emails.

KidzLife Club volunteer (TBD)

<u>Tuesday</u>: Attend GraceKidz staff meetings and prayer staff meetings along with scheduled All staff meetings. Create a weekly newsletter and schedule and send out to volunteers. Refill snack containers and restock supplies in each room. Add supplies to the shopping doc as needed.

Set room for Kiddoz when KidzLife resumes.

Wednesday: Work from home as needed-

Prep craft for Kiddoz when KidzLife resumes and add supplies to the shopping doc as needed. Check in with regular volunteers. Be at KidzLife beginning at 4:45 pm.

<u>Thursday</u>: Set up rooms for Sunday and answer emails, team specific meetings. Make sure the Comfort room is ready for each Sunday and provide a tour of the Comfort room to new visitors with babies.

<u>Sunday</u>: Supervise and assist in all Nursery and Pre-school hall rooms for both morning services, supervised child exchange, call/text parents during service for concerns, supervise and work with the gatekeepers.

Place dirty cups/snack cups and plastic toys in the dishwasher after 10:30 service. Empty diaper pails and place in large trash cans.

<u>Ongoing</u>: Visit any new babies and their families. Setup Meal Train for families with newborns as needed. Assist with any special events that are upcoming such as Baby dedication, KidzLife prep, volunteer appreciation events, volunteer training etc. Mother's Day/Father's Day craft for Nursery.
